### Wi-Fi Hotspot Lending Service

#### Wi-Fi Hotspot Borrowing Agreement and Use Internet to Go (Wi-Fi Hotspot Lending Service)

The Central Islip Public Library is offering **Internet to Go**: A Wi-Fi Hotspot lending service. The Hotspots can accommodate up to eight users or Wi-Fi devices at a time. Users only need an electrical outlet to charge the device.

**Central Islip Public Library lends Wi-Fi Hotspots to valid card holders age 18 and above.**

**Once the Wi-Fi hotspot is checked out to a patron, it becomes the responsibility of that patron. Damage to the device, cord, charging block, hotspot case or pouch, will result in a fee charged to the library card.**

**Hotspots are NOT eligible for renewal. Patrons will have to wait a period of one (1) week before checking out another hotspot.**

**Late fine: \$10.00/day. A \$100.00 replacement fee is billed after 10 days overdue.**

**Hotspot checkout is limited to one per household.**

**Lending period: Three Weeks.**

**Internet service will be turned off if a hotspot is not returned on the due date.**

**All components (hotspot, cord, charger, hotspot case and pouch) must be present and in good condition upon return for the library to consider the item, checked in.**

**Wi-Fi Hotspots must be returned to the CIPL, to a staff member at the Circulation Desk at least 1/2 hour before the library closes.**
